PHP

PHP is a powerful, open, and easy-to-use Web application environment. Live-Office web edition use PHP version 5.

MySQL

The MySQL database has become the world's most popular open source database because of its consistent fast performance, high reliability and ease of use. Live-Office web edition use the MySQL version 5.

Ajax / JavaScript

Ajax interface gives a new desktop style access to your personal information. Live-Office web edition use jQuery version *1.2.6 min* as the JavaScript Framework

Web Server

Live-Office web edition runs on any Linux web server with Kernel 2.4+. Apache (from release 1.3) web server software for any Linux distribution. Live-Office recommends Ubuntu Server Edition.

Minimum hardware requirement:

- Pentium III processor with at least 800 MHz
- System memory with least 512 MB
- Hard disk with at least 50MB; *More space is required for user files personal files*

Additional software requirement:

- Mail connectivity: Access to a SMTP relay, sendmail or similar protocol
- SSL encryption 2.0 or 3.0 (optional)

Login to Live-Office web edition via your favorite web browser. Live-Office web edition recommend Mozilla Firefox 2+.
